SUBJECT:	Deaf and Hard of Hearing in Government Employment and Technology Forum

Deaf and Hard of Hearing in Government (DHHIG) will host the 2008 DHHIG Employment and Technology Forum on May 1 at the U.S. Department of Transportation in Washington, D.C.
