The Federal Asian Pacific American Council's (FAPAC) Twentieth Annual National Leadership Training will be held May 31-June 3, 2005 in Crystal City, Virginia. This year's theme is "Bridging the Gap Between our Differences." FAPAC represents the interests of military and civilian employees of the Federal and District of Columbia governments in promoting equal employment opportunity and cultural diversity through education and recognition of outstanding performance.
